March 2017 BOM Instructions

- *Block size 24" x 24" finished (24.5" x 24.5" unfinished)
- *All seam allowances are 1/4"
- *Press all seams open, or as desired

Fabric choices required (please note that fabric choice numbers are listed on the photo to the right):


- 1 Main background
- 2 Large Star small points
- 3 Large & Inside Star background for points
 - 4 Large Star points
 - 5 Inside Star points
 - 6 Inside Star body
 - 7 Small Star points
 - 8 Small Star body




Cutting Instructions


- Main Background
 - o 19 4.5" squares from Fabric 1
- Large Star
 - o 4 2 1/8" squares from Fabric 1, then cut in half on the diagonal
 - o Cut 4 2.5" squares from Fabric 1
 - Cut 8 3" squares from Fabric 1
 - o 8 3" squares from Fabric 2
 - o **4** 2.5" squares from Fabric 3
 - Cut 4 2 ½ " squares from Fabric 3, then cut in half on the diagonal
 - Cut 4 4 ½ " squares from Fabric 4, then cut in half on the diagonal
- Inside Star
 - 4 2.5" squares from Fabric 3
 - o **4** 3.0" squares from Fabric 3
 - o **4** 3.0" squares from Fabric 5
 - o 1 4.5" square from Fabric 6
- Small Star
 - 4 1.5" squares from Fabric 1
 - 4 2.5" squares from Fabric 1
 - 4 2.5" squares from Fabric 7
 - 1 2.5" square from Fabric 8

- Sewing Instructions
 - Large Star points
 - Place eight 3.0" fabric 1 squares on eight 3.0" fabric 2 squares, right sides together.
 - On the lightest fabric of each pair draw a line from upper left corner to lower right corner.
 - Sew ¼' away from the line on both sides
 - Cut along the drawn line
 - You will now have 8 Half Square Triangle (HST) squares
 - Press seams
 - Trim all HST squares to 2.5"
 - Sew 1 2 ½" fabric 1 triangle to one side of a HST, sew 1 2 ½" fabric 3 triangle to the bottom of one HST. Sew 4 units as shown in the illustration of the left and 4 units as shown in the illustration on the right. Trim off any points.







■ Sew the above pieced triangles to one large 4 1/8" triangle along the long sides, being careful not to stretch the pieces while sewing. Press (don't iron) seams. This square should now measure 4.5".




■ Sew 1 2.5" fabric 1 square to one HST square. Sew 1 2.5" fabric 3 square to 1 HST square. Then sew together as shown below. Square should measure 4.5".




- Inside Star points
 - Place four 3.0" fabric 3 squares on four 3.0" fabric 5 squares, right sides together.
 - On the lightest fabric of each pair draw a line from upper left corner to lower right corner.
 - Sew ¼ away from the line on both sides
 - Cut along the drawn line
 - You will now have 8 HST squares
 - Press seams
 - Trim all HST squares to 2.5"
- Small Star points
 - Place four 2.5" fabric 1 background squares on four 2.5" fabric 6 squares, right sides together.
 - On the lightest fabric of each pair draw a line from upper left corner to lower right corner.
 - Sew ¼ away from the line on both sides
 - Cut along the drawn line
 - You will now have 8 HST squares
 - Press seams
 - Trim all HST squares to 1.5"
- Lay out stars as shown in the schematics below.
- Sew each star together, press seams and trim, if necessary
 - Small star should measure 4.5" unfinished



Inside star should measure 8.5" unfinished




■ Large star should measure 16.5" unfinished




Arrange the stars and background squares as shown on the schematic below
