## Feedback from Roe V Wade post

- Disclaimer on posts in the future
  - Discussion around political posting that happened in the past. We had 2 anonymous messages that were prior to moving the feedback form to the members only page. We can not make things better if we can't have a fulsome conversation on how to resolve this issue. We had many positive comments. There was no mention of anti-catholics, or anti-choice. We are still working with catholic charities. We don't want any to be excluded. Having an affirming place is not the only criteria for a new location to hold in person meeting.
